**RE: BILL 150 THE SECURITIES AMENDMENT ACT, 2023**

Dear Minister Eyre and Chair Dennis,

Thank you to Minister Eyre for the January 18, 2024, correspondence, and its recognition that the CSA, of which the Financial and Consumer Affairs Authority (FCAA) of Saskatchewan is a member, commenced a public consultation regarding proposed rule amendments to the independent dispute resolution services framework that would implement binding authority. The IIAC has actively participated in the ongoing CSA process and provided the attached informed analysis to the CSA.

Comments provided to the CSA have not yet been properly analyzed and considered, with any amendments subject to further public comment. Bill 150 notwithstanding proceeded to second reading on March 11, 2024. We agree with Ms. Nippi-Albright's interest in stakeholder input.

As the matter was committed to the Standing Committee on Intergovernmental Affairs and Justice, we continue to request that this Bill be removed from the Order Paper.
